## Carillon Bell Schedule



### Angelus Bell Toll

The Angelus bell is a call to prayer that tolls three times daily—at 6:00 a.m., 12:00 p.m., and 6:00 p.m. It rings in a specific 3-3-3-9 rhythm to remind the faithful to pause, reflect on the Incarnation, and recite the traditional Angelus prayer.



### Westminster Chime

The Westminster Chimes are a melodic sequence of sixteen notes played to mark each quarter-hour. Originating in 1793 from the Church of St Mary the Great in Cambridge, UK, they became globally iconic when adopted by Big Ben at the Palace of Westminster. The sequence consists of distinct musical phrases that expands to signal the time.



### De Profundis Toll

The "De Profundis" bell is a slow, solemn evening toll that calls the faithful to recite Psalm 130 (the De Profundis, meaning "out of the depths"). Traditionally rung at curfew (9:00 pm), this final evening bell bridges the daytime Angelus cycle into the night and serves as a community cue for families to finish their day, retire for the night, and pray for the souls in purgatory.



### Sunday Mass Chime

The Sunday Mass bell (the Calling), is scheduled to ring 5 minutes prior to the start of Mass. It serves as an invitation or calling to bring the local faithful out of their homes to come celebrate and worship. At one minute before the start of Mass, a one minute peal rings to remind the community that Mass is about to begin.
