

'Let it be Tokyo'

Prayer is not a 'magical means by which we get God' to do what we want. Prayer is our 'inner openness to God which allows ' his divine power to be released in us. 'Ultimately, the power of prayer is not ' that we succeed in changing God, but I that God succeeds in changing us.
